4. At the point of sale a placard must be displayed in a prominent location that states the following: "This product was produced in a home kitchen not subject to public health inspection that may also process common food allergens."

5. A cottage food operation may produce homeade food and drink with the exeption of food items listed under Section 4 Cottage Food Operation of the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act.
