**B. 2013 Historic Preservation Awards**

**C. National Register Public Outreach**

The Committee discussed how and when they should reach out to property owners in three potential National Register historic districts: Braucher/Duff Subdivision (1000 block S. Harvey), Hogans Home Subdivision (500-800 blocks Home), and Hulbert Subdivision (500-800 blocks Clinton and S. Kenilworth). Currently they are trying to determine if they are eligible for listing on the National Register. The Committee decided to wait until the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency has made a decision on eligibility before scheduling any official outreach meetings.
