Minutes

Chair Bruno called the meeting to order at 7:31pm

Public Comment - None

Chair Bruno requested a motion to approve the minutes from the May 19, 2015 meeting as drafted. The motion was proposed by Kevin Ochalla and seconded by Josh Luttig. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Deputy Chief Ambrose announced promotional Sergeant interviews scheduled for June 17 and 24 – there were 2 Chiefs and a Deputy Chief on the panel for the Oral Assessment Center Component that took place earlier in the month. There are 8 officer on extended medical leave which is affecting staffing – 4 are work related and 4 are on FMLA. Commission Luttig asked about the number of officers in the department – DC Ambrose confirmed that there are approximately 116 sworn officers, 16 sergeants, and 1 administrative officer. For background, DC Ambrose reminded the committee that the department switched to 12 hour shifts in 2011 with 2 platoons Day 6am -6pm, 7am – 7pm and Evening 6pm – 6am and 7pm -7am. We are one of the few departments with overlapping 12-hour shifts.

Currently Northwestern University is doing a study on shifts and should have a report ready within 6 weeks. The 5/2 schedule that is currently in place presents some scheduling challenges.

It was reported that crime is down 17% overall.

Chair Bruno announced that there is a new committee member Todd Moore who will be joining the meetings very shortly.

Chair Bruno announced that his term, as Chairman, would be up as of October 15, 2015.

The Meeting adjourned to Executive Session at 7:55pm.

Upon returning from Executive Session, the CPOC meeting was adjourned at 8:30pm.
