# B. MINUTES

Committee member Garapolo requested an edit to the minutes, clarifying that for item D (241 Wesley), the windows will be six inches apart. Committee member Carr agreed.

C. 327 Home Ave (Mazola Family, LLC): Certificate of Appropriateness to enlarge basement window on the side elevation to allow egress as part of larger interior renovation project (Ridgeland-Oak Park Historic District).

Manny Ganaden was present on behalf of the architect. Mr. Ganaden described the project to the Committee, explaining that they are adding additional living space within the basement, which is currently a storage area. The window will be enlarged to meet the light and vent requirement. The proposed plans do not need added egress.

Committee members Carr and Tadic agreed that the egress was the point of confusion for the Historic Preservation Commission. Committee member Carr asked about the windows that will be replaced. Planner Trexler said as they will not change in size, they do not require a Certificate of Appropriateness. Mr. Ganaden explained the window type proposed.
