III. Public Forum on the topic of Public Safety

These forums are designed to be less formal than the business meetings of a regular or special meeting, and instead are designed as discussions that allow for the Board, staff and the public to interact and have a dialogue on a variety of topics. Future discussions may include infrastructure, public health or economic development.

Members of the Oak Park Police Department, including Chief Rick Tanksley, will lead a discussion on how we collectively as a community think about public safety and what the community can do jointly with the Police Department to ensure we have the safest community possible. Residents are invited and encouraged to attend, listen and ask questions or provide comments.
